The following publications are peer-reviewed journals that address various disciplines of clinical and psychosocial care of children and families, including those with brain tumors and cancer. They are for both professionals and patient/caregiver audiences. This list is not intended to be exhaustive or exclusive. Note that most journals do not release free articles to the public until a year after their publication, but most can be obtained free of cost through a library database.

- The *Journal of Pediatric Psychology* publishes articles related to theory, research, and professional practice in pediatric psychology. Some articles include psychological and developmental effects of children affected by certain illnesses, including cancer.

- *The Journal of Psychosocial Oncology* publishes clinical and research material geared towards health professionals who provide psychosocial services to cancer patients, their families, and their caregivers. Critical areas of research include the stigma of cancer, employment and personal problems facing cancer patients; patient education; family involvement in patient care; children with cancer; the psychosocial needs of cancer patients; hospital and hospice staff; and volunteers.

#### *Neuropsychology*

The journal provides a forum for the dissemination of research in the basic and clinical sciences of multidisciplinary interest.

It will also include studies on such treatment options as hematopoietic stem cell transplantation, immunology, and gene therapy.

### Psycho-Oncology

- *Psycho-Oncology* is a monthly publication that focuses on the psychological, social, behavioral, and ethical aspects of cancer. It is also broken down into subspecialties which addresses the two major psychological dimensions of cancer: the psychological responses of patients to cancer at all stages of the disease, and that of their families and caretakers; and the psychological, behavioral, and social factors that may influence the disease process.

### Qualitative Health Research
